\$1.2 Million Challenge Grant

Pioneer Theatre Company (PTC) has been selected to receive a transformative \$1.2 Million Challenge Grant from a generous anonymous donor administered by the Community Foundation of Utah. This remarkable gift will unlock \$600,000 this fiscal year, but only if we raise \$1.76 million in additional support by June 30, 2026.

This challenge is more than a match: it's an invitation to invest in the future of professional theatre in Utah and ensure PTC continues to thrive as a vital part of the University of Utah and the Salt Lake City community.

Why it Matters

The Impact of Pioneer Theatre Company

55,000+ Audience Members Annually: each season, PTC brings transformative theatre experiences to thousands of people; sparking conversation, empathy, and a deeper sense of community connection across Utah.

Economic Driver: the broader Utah arts & culture sector (of which PTC is a key part) contributed over \$6.8 billion in economic activity in 2020, representing roughly 3.5 % of the state's GDP and supporting over 60,000 jobs.

Cultural Anchor: as Utah's only fully professional theatre in residence in the University of Utah, PTC elevates Salt Lake City's standing as a vibrant arts destination.

Educational Partner: through paid internships, PTC provides real-world training for University of Utah students pursuing careers in the arts.

Community Connector: PTC partners with schools, nonprofits, and local organizations to make theatre accessible and relevant to audiences of all ages and backgrounds. PTC's student programs support more than 10,000 students annually.


